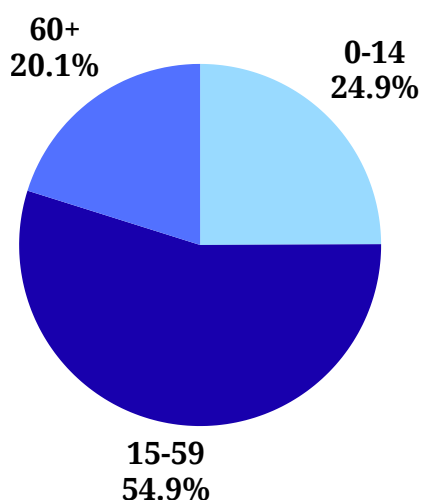
HEALTH CAMP: One day, thousands of lives touched
